## **Entry Instructions**

Only students can participate in poster contest in one of the following categories.

There is no template for the poster, the format is free.

## Poster size

The recommended poster size is A0 (1189 mm x 841 mm) portrait. Please ensure that your poster does not exceed this size. It is recommended that you leave a margin of at least 7.5 cm (3") around the poster. When preparing your poster consider how much of your poster will be visible at eye-level.

### **Poster Panel Allocation**

A numbered panel will be allocated for each poster (different from the abstract number you have been assigned) and staff will be at hand to assist you with the allocation.

# **Poster Fixing**

Please ask the staff for assistance or bring your own tape or clips.

### **Evaluation criteria**

A panel of several judges will evaluate the posters during the posters sessions.

If you do not wish to participate in the contest, please let the judge know.

You are requested to be present throughout the poster session otherwise your poster will be disqualified. Posters will be evaluated in several aspects.

**Poster Aesthetics:** Proper distribution of poster components. Excellent tables, graphs, and illustrations. Suitable font size and contrasted colors. Poster elements are not blurred or fuzzy.

**Grammatical issues**: Reading is clear, no grammatical errors, excessive text? Proper writing of scientific units in text, tables and graphs. Proper writing of chemical equations and scientific conventions. Axes in graphs are properly labeled.

**Poster contents:** title, authors, affiliation and logos, abstract, introduction, experimental or theoretical methodology, results and discussion, conclusions, bibliography, acknowledgements.

Sections are coherent and have enough information.

**Questioning**: Evaluator may ask you some questions.

For evaluation purposes referees will take a picture of contestants along with their poster.

#### **Evaluation**

For each poster session, a finalist will be declared for each day. After the last poster session, judges will meet to decide on the best three posters.

#### **Prizes**

For each category a public recognition and certificate will be awarded. The prize will be announced soon.

Winners will be announced by Friday 31.
